The forum is organized on the initiative of the S. I. Yuriy Department of Finance of West Ukrainian National University together with the State Educational-Scientific Institution "The Academy of Financial Management" of the Ministry of Finance of Ukraine

Modern is a new philosophy of the style of cognition, which is based on the rejection of traditional classical principles, norms and rules in favor of the latest smooth cyclical forms of systematic cognition and asymmetry.

Cyclicity is an objective form of development of the object of knowledge as a single whole, which has a regular character and occurs in the process of movement from one equilibrium to another, without reaching the limit of absolute balancing. The transformation of finance has a spiral character, from a lower to a higher level of development. Smooth sequential cyclical forms of system knowledge make it possible to build and scientifically substantiate the foundation for the progressive development of finance.

The main thesis of the First International Financial Forum is that it is impossible to achieve a state of financial equilibrium and an ideal balancing of financial instruments in society. The task of the scientific community is, together with practitioners, to constantly search for scientific substantiation of new dimensions of the development of the financial system for the safe and effective use of finances as attributes of state-building at every stage of the socio-economic development of society.

The main goal and mission of the First International Financial Forum is the exchange of experience and opinions of representatives of the scientific community and practitioners in solving current problems of the transformation of the financial space in the conditions of global challenges and threats. A wide range of issues will be discussed in the framework of panel discussions and workshops regarding innovative vectors of development of financial science and practice, modern security and globalization trends in financial policy in Ukraine and abroad. The background of the First International Financial Forum is the full-scale Russian-Ukrainian war and granting Ukraine the status of a candidate for membership in the European Union.

All Forum participants will receive certificates indicating the total number of academic hours - 60 hours (2 ECTS credits).




